

Opportunities To Be Involved

Adult and youth volunteers are vital to making Pioneer Clubs a success. All parents are required to find a place to help on a regular basis. The following opportunities are available:

Club Guides and Assistant Guides—Help children explore the Bible in fun and meaningful ways. (Training is provided; weekly lesson preparation and regular club attendance are expected.)

Classroom Support—Help in the classroom on a monthly basis, send weekly email parent reminders, help prepare crafts for guides, etc.

Games/Activities Team—Plan and lead games and activities each week.

Clubs Support—Greet kids, collect dinner money, record attendance, help where it's needed.
